## Industry Moves

- **Nicodim Gallery Adds Stanley Edmondson:** The Los Angeles–based ceramicist works primarily with homemade clay for large sculptures influenced by the Funk art movement. Edmondson’s solo presentation at the Nicodim’s Los Angeles location, “Stanley’s Playground,” closes on September 14.
- **Company Gallery Brings on Sixten Sandra Österberg:** The Swedish painter’s inaugural solo exhibition at Company, “Familiar Openings,” closed on April 20.
- **Gathering Announces Representation of Soojin Kang:** The London gallery will present a solo exhibition by the South Korean artist next fall.
- **Venus Over Manhattan Brings on Claude Lawrence:** The New York–based abstract painter’s first solo exhibition at the gallery, “Reflections on Porgy & Bess,” featured 22 new works and closed in May.
- **Tampa Museum of Art Picks Beck Group For Expansion:** The architecture and construction firm has been chosen to manage the construction of the institution’s 77,904-square-foot Centennial Expansion project.
