Industry Moves

- *Munisha Underhill Joins Locust Projects as First Deputy Director:* Before joining Locust Projects, Miami's longest-running nonprofit alternative art space, Underhill served as vice president for development at Oolite Arts.
- Jeremy Frey Receives Rappaport Prize from the deCordova Sculpture Park and Museum: The Passamaquoddy basket maker is the first Indigenous artist to win the award.
- *Ryan Lee Gallery to Represent George Nelson Preston:* A solo exhibition of Preston's work, "Ayahuasca Notebook Paintings: Journeys and Returns," opens on September 5.
- Venus Over Manhattan Takes on Multidisciplinary Artist Brad Kahlhamer: The gallery will present a solo exhibition of Kahlhamer's work at the Independent 20th Century art fair, which opens on September 5.
- Mexico City's Llano to Co-Represent Giovanni Fabián Guerrero with Cherán, Mexico's Chérpiri Gallery: The Purhépeca artist's second solo exhibition with Llano, "Senderos ocultos," opens on September 7.
- *Marti Meyerson Elected Chair of SITE Santa Fe's Board of Directors:* A board member since 2017, she will succeed Marleen Debode in the role.
- Anonymous Was a Woman Names Recipients of 2024 Environmental Art Grants: The organization awarded a total of \$308,000 to 19 artist projects, including ones by Shayla Blatchford, Emily Cohen Ibañez, Victoria-Idongesit Udondian, and Colleen Thurston.
- *Robert Rauschenberg Foundation Names Chief Operating Officer:* Berenice Fernandez Sarafzadeh joins from the Yale Center for British Art, beginning October 1. Among her charges will be the completion of the foundation's residency facilities on Captiva Island in Florida.
